








TFT Summary



Training Faithful Trainers is a method of making disciples which is designed for new believers. It is a direct response to Jesus' command to "go and make disciples . . . baptising them . . . and teaching them to obey all that I commanded you." TFT aims to achieve three primary goals:

1. To develop a lifestyle of obedience to Jesus, giving highest priority to sharing the gospel
2. To teach believers how to be disciples and equip them to be disciple makers
3. To learn and practise the New Testament church, preparing believers to start new churches
