

# TFT Prayer Worksheet

Prayer is a wonderful privilege which allows us to approach God and speak directly with Him! It is also a vital part of the life of every disciple that helps us grow in intimacy with our Heavenly Father.

In Matthew 6.9-13, Jesus teaches how to pray by giving us a model prayer. Using this model, write out your own prayer to God using the 5 things Jesus teaches us to include in our prayers.

*“Pray like this...”*

<p><b>PRAISE</b>  <i>“Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name”</i> (verse 9)</p> <p>What can you say to God about His greatness, the things He has done, or your love for Him?</p>	
<p><b>PURPOSE</b>  <i>“Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven”</i> (verse 10)</p> <p>What can you say to God about His Kingdom, His plan for the world, or your part in His work?</p>	
<p><b>PROVISION</b>  <i>“Give us this day our daily bread”</i> (verse 11)</p> <p>What can you say to God about the everyday things you need, or the needs of others?</p>	
<p><b>PARDON</b>  <i>“Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors”</i> (verse 12)</p> <p>What can you say to God about your sins, and about your forgiveness of other people?</p>	
<p><b>PROTECTION</b>  <i>“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one”</i> (verse 13)</p> <p>What can you say to God about protecting you from temptation and the influence of Satan?</p>	
<p>Include the phrase “In Jesus’ name” because Jesus makes possible our connection with God.</p> <p>“Amen” expresses our agreement with God.</p>
