A Serious Question:
Who Is Jesus Christ?

If Jesus is only a man:

- Why does Scripture call Him God? (John 20:28)
- Why is He worshipped? (Matthew 28:17)
- Why does He forgive sins? (Mark 2:7)

These are not side issues. They sit at the very centre of the gospel (1 Corinthians 15:1–4).

Another Question: Is the Holy Spirit just the manifest signs of God's Power?



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What Does the Bible Actually Says:

- Jesus existed before Abraham (John 1:1-5; 8:58; Ex 3:14)
- All things were made through Him (John 1:3)
- In Him dwells the fullness of deity (Colossians 2:9)

Reducing Jesus changes:

- His identity and Authority
- The meaning of the cross (Isa 53; Rom 3:21-26)
- The nature of salvation (John 3:16-18)

The Holy Spirit **chooses, speaks, sends, can be lied to, grieved**, and is **named** with Father and Son — actions Scripture reserves only for a person, not a force. (Acts 5:3-4; 13:2-4; 16:7; Eph 4:30; 1 Cor 12:11; 2 Cor 13:14; Isa 63:10; Matt 28:19)

Why have personal titles: **Him, counsellor, helper, teacher, witness**, etc? (Jn 14:16,26; 15:26, 16:7; Rom 8:26)

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
